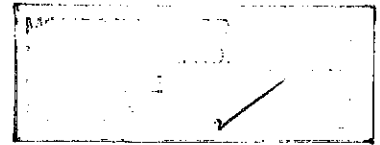

A RESOLUTION

**SUPPORTING THE US 422 CORRIDOR  
REDEVELOPMENT PLAN**

**WHEREAS,** the US 422 Corridor Redevelopment Plan is a collaborative effort involving the City of Youngstown, City of Girard, Trumbull County Commissioners, Trumbull Metropolitan Housing Authority (TMHA), Trumbull County Land Reutilization Corporation (TCLRCS), Western Reserve Port Authority (WRPA), Mahoning County Land Reutilization Corporation (MCLRC), Youngstown Metropolitan Housing Authority (YMHA), Raymond John Wean Foundation, Youngstown Foundation, Community Foundation of the Mahoning Valley, Community Foundation of Eastern Ohio and Western Pennsylvania and Vallourec Star; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Youngstown was a participating member of the US 422 Corridor Redevelopment Planning Process; and

That the Council of the City of Youngstown hereby recognizes the importance of collaborative planning.


**SECTION 2**

That the Council of the City of Youngtown supports the recommendation and initiatives contained in the US 422 Corridor Redevelopment Plan.



That the Clerk of Council is hereby instructed to forward a copy of this resolution to individuals as designated by Council


